During a day on the job site, your team will work alongside a Habitat partner family to help them build their home. Group construction tasks offer great opportunities to strengthen workplace skills.

Team Build Day Info

Group Size: We welcome groups of up to 10 individuals per shift.

Location and Schedule: For up to date location information call the office or visit our website, *www.roguevalleyhabitat.org.* shifts are 9:00am to 12:00pm or 12:00pm to 3:00pm. Please arrive promptly at 9:00am or 12:00pm for safety training.

Dates: Tuesday through Friday and some Saturdays. Please provide a date range and preferred day of the week, and we will let you know what dates are open that match your availability.

Lunch: Lunch is a great time to take a break and learn more about Habitat. It is expected that your team will arrange to provide lunch on the job site for your group and any other volunteers that day. Please assign lunch duties to willing members of your team. (unless provided in your home sponsorship package)

Waiver: Volunteers must sign a waiver. The minimum volunteer age is 18 years due to insurance liabilities and the use of power tools on the job site.

What to Wear/Bring: Habitat builds in all weather conditions, so dress for the weather. Wear sturdy, comfortable clothing that you do not mind getting dirty or stained. All tools and safety hats are provided.

Rogue Valley Habitat for Humanity was formed in 1987 under the umbrella of Habitat for Humanity International, which has been operating since 1976. Since then, we have partnered with more than 72 local families to build simple and sustainable homes in Jackson County, OR. The homes are sold to our partner families at no profit with an affordable monthly mortgage payment.



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Additional ways our business community gives back

Employee matching gift programs allocate corporate dollars to causes that their employees are passionate about.

Corporations do this by matching donations to nonprofits that their employees support. Typically, companies with these programs match donations dollar for dollar - effectively doubling employee contributions. It's a win-win situation for everyone:

- Employees can double their donations to organizations they care about.
- Nonprofits receive additional funding without having to attract new donors.
- Corporations can offer a benefit that employees appreciate, receive tax benefits, and can give back to a diverse set of nonprofits.

Matching gift programs are based on the idea that taking a bottoms-up approach works for corporate philanthropy. With over 65 percent of Fortune 500 companies offering these programs, including many of the <u>nation's leading employers</u>, some of your donors or members undoubtedly work for companies that will match their donations.



The typical structure provides grants of around \$10 - \$15 per volunteer hour as long as an employee volunteers with the organization on a regular basis (for instance, 20+ hours in a year).

PAID-RELEASE DAYS



Do you offer your employees a few paid release day each year, where it allows an employee or many employees to spend a day or two volunteering during normal work hours while on the company payroll?



NON-CASH DONATIONS (In-Kind)



Although most companies provide cash donations, some companies prefer to give back to communities in other ways. A typical example is a manufacturing company that can offer a greater benefit to organizations through product donations rather than cash contributions.

For instance, food manufacturers are one of the largest suppliers of food to food pantries. Lumber companies give building materials for charities such as Habitat for Humanity.

On a more local level, make sure you're asking local businesses to sponsor events.

The Win/Win of Event Sponsorship

- 1. There are many business benefits of sponsorship, but here are the most common:
- 2. Attracting customers to a brand and keeping them interested.
- 3. Distinguishing the company's brand from competitor brands.
- 4. Changing or strengthening a brand image by humanizing it.
- 5. Improving company or product awareness and visibility
- 6. Driving customers to a retail store or a particular product.
- 7. Showing community responsibility, or corporate social responsibility
- 8. Getting more involved with a community.
- 9. Building the company's credibility and educating the public about its products and services
- 10. Persuading the public to sample a new product or to demonstrate a new product or service
- 11. Entertaining key clients (can be substantial when sponsoring cultural or athletic events)
- 12. Targeting a particular market.
- 13. Recruiting, retaining or motivating employees
- 14. Nurturing talent and teaching new skills to employees

COMPANY WIDE DAY OF SERVICE EVENTS

Consider partnering with Habitat for Humanity in a company-wide day of service.

These events require an immense amount of pre-event coordination, but if you can pull it off, your organization can benefit from a large group of skilled volunteers. As an added benefit, companies also frequently provide funding for these events.



One tip for organizations looking to pull these events off successfully is to design appropriate sized chunks of work that can be finished by groups of company employees in a single day.



ADULT WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Oregon nonprofit corporation, its directors, officers, employees and agents (collectively, "HfH/RV"). THE VOLUNTEER DOES HEREBY FREELY, VOLUNTARILY AND WITHOUT DURESS EXECUTE THIS RELEASE UNDER THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

1. Waiver and Release: Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless HfH/RV and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's work for HfH/RV.

Volunteer understands that this Release discharges HfH/RV from any liability or claim that the Volunteer may have against HfH/RV with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death or property damage that may result from Volunteer's work for Habitat, whether caused by the negligence of HfH/RV or its officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. Volunteer also understands that HfH/RV does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

- **2. Medical Treatment**: Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge HfH/RV from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with HfH/RV.
- **3. Assumption of the Risk**: The Volunteer understands that the work for HfH/RV may include activities that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading and transportation to and from the wok sites Volunteer hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in these activities and releases HfH/RV from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from the activities of the Volunteer's work for HfH/RV
- **4. Insurance:** The Volunteer understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by HfH/RV in writing; HfH/RV does not carry or maintain health, medical or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer. **Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.**
- **5. Photographic Release:** Volunteer does hereby grant and convey unto HfH/RV all right, title and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by HfH/RV during the Volunteer's work for Habitat, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.
- **6. Other:** Volunteer expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Oregon, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon. Volunteer agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of the Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.
